The research aims to identify and map the green skills and competences required for two emerging occupations in the (TCLF) sector: **Bio textile technician** and **Recycling Manager**.

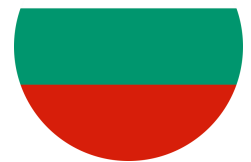
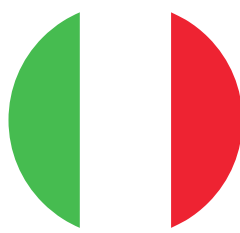
It focuses on defining and mapping these two occupations and identifying the knowledge, competences, and skills needed to carry out these jobs.
